

CHOOSE FROM SEVERAL OPTIONS TO EARN A NURSING DEGREE

ASSOCIATE DEGREE NURSE (RN):

RNs work in a variety of medical settings: hospitals, surgery/outpatient clinics, long-term care, home health, public health departments, schools and physician offices.

Application deadline: February 1**

Upon completion, graduates are eligible to apply for the RN licensing exam (NCLEX-RN).

Lake Land has dual enrollment and completion agreements with Illinois universities to assist students in completing a BSN degree online while working as a registered nurse.

If interested, select AAS.ADN.TRK as your major.

PRACTICAL NURSING (PN):

LPNs work in a variety of medical settings, long-term care, hospitals, clinics and physicians' offices.

This is a year certificate, no prerequisites or co-requisites (total 41 credit hours).

Application deadline: March 1**

Upon completion, graduates are eligible to apply for the PN licensing exam (NCLEX-PN).

LPNs can bridge to the ADN program (requires a bridge course and one additional year of coursework).

If interested, select CERT.PN.TRK as your major.

ADMISSION PROCESS

Both options are Special Admission programs. Applicants must submit an application to the college and a separate application to the program. **An Admissions exam (offered first Friday of September, October, November, December) and prerequisites must be completed prior to application deadline.
