2017 ANNUAL GRADUATE REPORT

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Introduction

The Lake Land College Annual Graduate Report provides a summary of two perspectives on graduation over time. The first section of the report consists of an overview of the students who graduate from Lake Land College each year. This annual overview includes student demographics, the number and types of degrees distributed, and the number of graduates by division/DOC facility and program. Both college and Department of Corrections (DOC) students are included in this section of the report. Data in this section of the report represent graduates in the 2012-2013 through the 2016-2017 academic years.

The second section of the report presents graduation data by student cohorts. These student cohorts include all first time degree seeking students who begin their academic career in the summer or fall semester. The first student cohort presented is the summer/fall 2005 student cohort. These cohorts are followed for 6 years after beginning their academic career at Lake Land College and cohorts will be added to the report as they reach a 2 year follow up point. For example, the current report includes summer/fall 2005 through summer/fall 2015 student cohorts since the 2015 student cohort has reached its second academic year as potential enrollees at Lake Land. This section of the report presents the number of students who receive degrees each year as well as the graduation rate for the cohort. This information provides overall numbers and graduation rates as well as number of students and graduation rates by degree and student type (i.e., college students and DOC students). For college students, the number of students and graduation rates are also provided by student demographics including gender, race, age status, student load, athletic status, dual credit status, and disability status. Three variables were added to the report in 2009. These variables include veteran status, PELL grant eligibility status, and first generation students. The data for these three variables begins with the fall 2009 student cohorts because the intent to enroll form was modified around 2010 to include veteran and first generation demographic questions.

Section I: Annual Graduation Information

This section of the report presents graduation data for the past 5 years, beginning in 2012-2013 and ending with 2016-2017. Table 1 provides a breakdown of the number of percent of graduates and degrees and certificates awarded by student category (i.e., college students and DOC students). Results indicate that over the past 5 years, on average around 39% of all graduates are college students and 61% are DOC students. It appears that in FY2017 DOC students outpaced college students in relation to graduating with degrees and/or certificates.

Table 2 presents the number and percentages of college and DOC graduates that receive only degrees, only certificates, or degrees and certificates. The majority of college graduates (62% on average-down from an average of 73% in 2015-2016) receive a degree while the majority of DOC graduates receive certificates (87% on average). However, when looking at all the graduates, approximately 64% of awards distributed annually are certificates.

Table 3 summarizes the number and percent of college students who graduated by academic year and demographics. The number and percentages are based on unduplicated students not on the number of degrees and certificates distributed. Students can receive multiple degrees and/or certificates when they graduate and the number of awards distributed each year is also provided in Table 1. However, the number and percent of students by demographic characteristic is based on the number of unique students who graduated.

Results for college student graduates indicate the following:

- Between the 12-13 and 16-17 academic years, around 61% of Lake Land graduates were women
- The vast majority of our graduates are Caucasian, which is reflective of the student population as well as the district population.
- In general, about 57% of the graduates are between the ages of 17 and 23 across the 12-13 and 16-17 academic years.
- Over 90% of our graduating students are in district students.
- The percent of graduates who are athletes ranges between two and three percent each year.
- The average percent of graduates who were dual credit participants is around 38%. This percentage has increased between 12-13 (33.2%) and 1-176 (41.1%).

Table 4 presents the number and percent of DOC students who graduated by academic year and demographics. Again, these numbers and percentages are based on unduplicated students not on the number of degrees and certificates awarded.

Results for DOC graduates indicate the following:

- In FY2017 100% of the DOC graduates are men which reflect the population of students in DOC facilities where Lake Land provides services. In fact, the only female DOC facility for which LLC provided services closed during fiscal year 2014.
- The percent of graduates who are Black ranges from around 43 to 46% across the 5 years. The next largest percentage of DOC graduates is white. The percent of white graduates ranges from 39 to 44%.
- A higher percentage of DOC graduates are older when compared to college students. In fact around 91% of DOC graduates are 24 and older compared to only about 43% of college graduates who are 24 and older.

Table 5 combines both college and DOC graduate demographics. Some of the demographic breakdowns change significantly when looking at both college and DOC graduates together due to the large differences in the two populations in age, gender, and race/ethnicity.

Results for the combined college and DOC student graduates show the following:

- On average 76% of all graduates are men and 24% are women.
- The percent of white graduates averages around 61% while the percent of Black graduates averages about 28%.
- Around 73% of all graduates are 24 years and older while approximately 27% are less than 23 years.
- On average 62% of all graduates are DOC students.

Tables 6 through 8 provide a summary of the number and percent of graduates by degrees and certificates (e.g., AA, AAS, AES, ALS, AS, and Certificates) for college students only (Table 6), DOC students only (Table 7), and for all students (Table 8). These number and percentages are based on the total number of degrees and certificates distributed each academic year <u>NOT</u> on the number of unduplicated students.

Results in Table 6 reveal an average of 71% of all degrees and certificates distributed to college students annually are career and technical degrees/certificates and approximately 29% of the awards are transfer degrees. Approximately 32% of the degrees and certificates awarded annually to college students are Associate in Applied Science degrees followed by certificates, which account for an additional 36% of awards. In 2016-2017 the percent of Associate in Science degrees decreased dramatically while Associate in Arts degrees increased dramatically. To maintain an Associate in Science degree, the state of Illinois changed the requirements/credit hours for math and science and humanities and social science in FY16. The transition from Associate in Science (AS) to Associate in Arts (AA) in several academic programs was thoroughly studied by our academic area. Upon review, it was decided that the additional math and science hours required in the revised General Education Core Curriculum (GECC) for Associate in Science provided the most benefit for successful 4 year transfer only in specific majors such as the Pre-Professional Sciences. Students enrolled in other disciplines such as Business or Agriculture would benefit more from the Humanities and Social Science components offered in the (AA) (GECC) and be better served in their successful matriculation to a 4 year institution. Due to this change, AA programs are now the most common transfer degrees awarded to Lake Land students.

As shown in Table 7, almost all of the degrees and certificates awarded to DOC students are career and technical degrees/certificates. The percent of transfer degrees falls below 1% for DOC students across the five years. As a result, almost all of the degrees awarded to DOC students annually are career and technical degrees/certificates, of which at least 90% are certificates. The next largest percentages of degrees awarded are Associate in Liberal Studies which account for the remaining 10% of degrees and certificates.

When combining both student populations in Table 8, the breakdown of degree and certificates changes. Around 89% of degrees awarded are career and technical degrees/certificates and about 11% of degrees and certificates are transfer degrees. The highest proportion of awards consists of certificates, which account for around 71% of degrees and certificates. Around 11% of all degrees and

certificates awarded are Associate in Applied Science, and about 6% of all awards are Associate in Science degrees.

Each section of Table 9¹ presents an overview of the number of degrees and certificates disseminated annually by each Division and program to college students for the academic years 2012-2013 through 2016-2017. The numbers and percentages presented in this table are based on the total number of degrees and certificates awarded, <u>NOT</u> on the number of unique students who graduated that academic year. This table is separated by academic division and each program within the divisions is listed. The number of degrees/certificates column provides the number of degrees awarded for that program by academic year. The percent of degrees by division provides the percent of degrees/certificates awarded for a program based on the total number of divisional degrees and certificates, and the percent of total degrees and certificates shows the percent of degrees/certificates awarded to a program based on the total number of awards for the academic year. For example, in 2016-2017 36 Associate of Arts degrees in agriculture were distributed to students, which is 24.3% of all of the agriculture degrees awarded that academic year (i.e., percent of degrees/certificates).

Results for Table 9 indicate the following:

Agriculture

- Of the degrees and certificates awarded annually to students in the Agriculture Division, on average 59% are AAS degrees, 24% are AA degrees, and 17% are certificates.
- On an annual basis, Agriculture students receive about 10% of all AA degrees, 19% of all AAS degrees, and 5% of certificates.
- On average around 10% of ALL annual degrees and certificates are distributed to students in Agriculture programs.

- Of the degrees and certificates awarded annually to students in the Technology Division, on average 33% are AAS degrees and 67% are certificates.
- On an annual basis Technology students receive about 14% of all AAS degrees and 26% of certificates.
- On average around 14% of ALL annual degrees and certificates are distributed to students in Technology programs.

All Degrees

- Between the 2012-2013 and 2016-2017 academic years, Lake Land awarded 5,975 degrees to students, which is an average of 1,195 degrees per year.
- Of the degrees and certificates awarded annually to all students, on average 36% are certificates, 32% are AAS degrees, 25% are AA degrees, and 4% are AS degrees. On average, less than 1% of degrees awarded annually are AES degrees and around 2.9% are ALS degrees.

Table 10 summarizes the number of degrees and certificates awarded in an academic year by DOC facility and program and Table 11 presents the total number of degrees and certificates by program for all DOC facilities. As indicated in Table 11, the program producing the largest number of degrees or certificates by far is custodial maintenance which produced 2,239 awards over the five reporting years. Other popular programs include all construction occupations certificates (2,154 awards total), all auto repair and basic auto certificates (1,136 awards total) warehousing and distribution (810 awards), food service/culinary arts (1,448 awards), and horticulture (854). The Associate in Liberal Studies (ALS) program distributed 1,113 awards over the five reporting years.

Section II: Annual Student Cohort Information

The data discussed in this section reflect the rate of graduation over time with student cohorts. The cohorts consist of first time degree and certificate seeking students² who start in the fall term beginning in 2005. These student cohorts are followed for 6 years and the data are presented in the tables. For the purposes of this report, dual credit participants who have graduated from high school and are attending Lake Land for the first time as a college student seeking a degree or certificate are considered first time students. For example, a dual credit participant who graduated from high school in the spring of 2005 and attended Lake Land in the fall of 2005 is a member of the fall 2005 student cohort. DOC students are only included in Tables 13, 14 and 15 of this section. The remaining tables (i.e., Tables 12 and 16 through 25) include only college students who have graduated. Tables 23 through 25 present data for student cohorts beginning in fall 2009 around this time is when veteran and first generation college student information began to appear on the intent to enroll form.

Table 12 reflects the number of unique students in their respective student cohort that have graduated with a degree and/or certificate 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 years after enrolling in Lake Land for the first time as a degree or certificate seeking student. Students who receive more than one degree in different years (e.g., a certificate one year post enrollment and an associate degree two years post enrollment) are included only once in the table. In Table 12, the number of graduates with a degree or certificate show unique numbers of students as they graduate. For example, for the fall 2005 student cohort of 1,087 students, 45 received a degree or certificate within one year of enrollment. An additional 222 students received a degree within two years of enrollment, and an additional 83 students received a degree within three years of enrollment. The cumulative graduation number adds the number of unique students over time. As a result, within two years of enrollment 267 students (24.5%) in the 2005 cohort have received a degree. Table 13 presents the same information for DOC students only and Table 14 combines the college and DOC students into one student cohort.

Table 15 provides a summary of the type of degrees and certificates awarded each year for both college and DOC students separately. The majority of degrees received by students within one year of enrollment involve certificates. However, within two and three years of enrollment the number of associate degrees increases dramatically and the number of certificates awarded declines for college students. The data in this table represents the fall 2010 through fall 2015 cohorts. Data for the fall 2005 through 2009 cohorts can be found in previous years' annual reports.

² Degree seeking students are students who are enrolled in a degree or certificate program that requires 24 or more credit hours to complete the degree or certificate.

These numbers reflect the number of degrees and certificates awarded. Students can receive multiple degrees. As a result, these numbers reflect duplicated students.

Tables 16 through 22 present the cumulative graduation rate of college students only by demographic characteristics including gender, race, traditional/non-traditional age, part and full time status, athletic status, dual credit, and disability status. Tables 23 through 25 summarize the cumulative graduation rate of college students only for veterans, Pell eligible students, and first generation students. The student cohorts for these tables begin with fall of 2009. These tables provide the total number of unique students in the cohort by demographic (i.e., females and males). In addition, these tables track the cumulative number of graduates in these categories and provide the graduation rate for these demographic categories over time. For example, the fall 2005 student cohort consisted of 553 women and 538 men. Of these women a total of 32 graduated within one year of enrollment and 150 graduated within two years of enrollment (i.e., 32 within one year and 118 in the second year for a total of 150). Over time, it appears that women graduate at higher rates than men for the 2005 student cohort. Based on the data provided in Tables 16 through 21 the following observations can be made:

- Graduation rates tend to be fairly similar for men and women. However, over time it appears
 that women tend to graduate at slightly higher rates than men.
- Table 17 illustrates that white students tend to graduate at much higher rates than minority students. This difference is consistent over time within and across student cohorts.
- Traditional aged students (i.e., students 23 and younger) tend to graduate at higher rates than their non-traditional aged counterparts. This difference is consistent over time within and across student cohorts with the exception of the 2009 student cohort.
- As seen in Table 19 below, full time students are much more likely to graduate than part time students. In fact, with the exception of the 2006 student cohort, full time students are at least twice as likely to have graduated within 3 years of enrollment when compared to part time students.
- Athletes tend to graduate at higher rates than non-athletes at Lake Land. The 2008 student cohort seems to be an enigma when compared to the other cohorts.
- Table 21 presents data related to in-district recent high school graduates only. For example, the cohorts for this table includes only the in-district high school students who graduated the previous spring (i.e., 2015) and enrolled at Lake Land in the fall of 2015 for the first time as a college students. Over time, students who participated in the dual credit program in high school are more likely to graduate than students who have not participated in dual credit programs with the exception of the fall 2012 cohort.
- Overall it appears that students with disabilities are less likely to graduate than their non-disabled counterparts. In some cases, the graduation rate appears to be fairly close (e.g., year 4 for 2007 cohort) or even higher for students with disabilities (e.g., year 6 for 2006 cohort). In these cases, it is important to look at the number of individual students in each group. In some of these cases, the number of students with disabilities is very small (i.e., less than 20 total students).

The findings relating to veteran students are very interesting, and it will be crucial to follow this population closely over time to determine how the results may change. At this point, seven cohorts have at least two years of findings related to graduation, and the findings for each cohort vary slightly. The 2009 cohort have a higher percentage of veterans graduating at four and six years post entry than non-veterans while three years post for the 2010 cohort show that non veterans are twice as likely as veterans to graduate. With these cohorts, it appears that overall non-veterans are more likely to graduate than veterans with the exception of the 2009 cohort. Again the small number of veterans in the cohorts may impact the validity of the results. In addition, the number of veterans enrolled may be underreported, since some students may overlook this variable on the intent to enroll form.

Lake Land College began to collect first generation college information in 2009. This variable includes an unknown number because many students either did not complete the form with the first generation question, do not know the educational level of their parents, or did not answer the question. Given the decreasing number of students in the unknown category over time, it is clear that more students are able to complete this question. The results available at this point seem to indicate that at four or more years post enrollment first generation students are less likely to graduate than their non-first generation counterparts. Between the 2009 and 2011 cohorts, students with unknown first generation status are also more likely to graduate than their first generation counterparts.
