




Number of Students Enrolled (Headcount)





Credit Hours/Full-Time Equivalent









Additional Fall 2017 Enrollment Highlights

- 142 Presidential Scholars from the Class of 2017.
- 1,679 (34%) students enrolled in at least one Internet class. 515 (10%) enrolled in only Internet classes.
- 525 (11%) students enrolled in at least one class at the Kluthe Center.
 209 (4%) students enrolled only at Kluthe Center.
- 41 international students representing 19 countries.
- 118 students sponsored through dislocated worker programs.
