

ANNUAL GRADUATION FAST FACTS

August 2018

COLLEGE STUDENTS

- 1,105 students graduated from Lake Land College with a degree or certificate in Fiscal Year 2018.
- A total of 1,307 degrees and certificates were awarded to the 1,105 graduating students.
- Around 58% of graduates received degrees, 31% received certificates, and 10% received degrees and certificates.
- 60% of graduates were female and 40% were male.
- 63% of graduates were of traditional age (i.e., 17 to 23) and 37% were 24 or older.
- 42% of graduates were dual credit participants.
- 28% of awards were transfer degrees (AA, AES, or AS) and the remaining 72% were AAS (28.7%), ALS (2.7%) and certificates (40.6%).

 - AAS 28.7%
 - AES 0.6%
 - ALS 2.7%
 - AS 12.6%
 - CRT 40.6%
- Percent of total degrees and certificates by Division
 - Agriculture 9.9%
 - Allied Health 24.9%
 - Business 27.5%
 - Humanities 4.1%
 - Math and Science 7.3%
 - Social Science and Education 10.1%
 - Technology 13.5%

DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS (DOC)

- 1,696 DOC students graduated from Lake Land College with a degree or certificate in Fiscal Year 2018.
- A total of 2,417 degrees and certificates were awarded to the graduating students.
- Around 5% received degrees, 89% received certificates, and 5% received degrees and certificates.
- 100% of DOC graduates were male. Lake Land does no longer provides services to female correctional facilities.
- 42% of graduates were African American, 42.2% were Caucasian, and 9% were Hispanic.
- 92% were 24 years and older.
- 7% of awards were Associate in Liberal Studies degrees and the remaining 93% were certificates.
- Most popular programs awarding certificates across all correctional sites
 - 15.3% Custodial Maintenance
 - 19.7% Construction Occupations I and II
 - 18.3% Culinary Arts I and II
 - 1439% Horticulture
