Lake Land College Spectator Protocol for Inside Laker Field House

Please review the following information provided by Lake Land College Athletics.

To Gain Admission to the Game

-Each student athlete on the home roster will be allowed 2 tickets, which will be on a pass list. If not on the pass list you will not be allowed to enter the field house.

To Gain Admission to Campus at Check Point

-Compete the Campus Visitor Screening Form and bring email with you to present at the checkpoint. https://www.lakelandcollege.edu/campus-visitor-approval-form/

Upon Arrival to Field House:

- -Spectators will not be allowed to enter the fieldhouse until 30 minutes prior to scheduled game time.
- -You will enter the main entrance of the fieldhouse.
- -Upon entering the field house the spectators will be temperature checked by Lake Land College Athletics Staff.
- -If a person has a temperature check above 100.4 that group will not be allowed into the field house.
- -Home spectators only with a max of 50.
- -Seating will be in groups of two or grouped by household, and each group will be social distanced.
- -There will be no concessions available and we ask that you only bring drinks into the venue, no food.
- -Masks covering nose and mouth will be required at all times in the field house.
- -Once game is compete we will ask that you immediately exit the building, no congregating or interaction with the student athletes.

To Gain Admission to Campus at Check Point

-Compete the Campus Visitor Screening Form and bring email with you to present at the checkpoint. https://www.lakelandcollege.edu/campus-visitor-approval-form/

Upon Arrival to Laker Fields

- -You will need to park in parking lot A
- -Bleachers and from dugout to dugout will be restricted areas.
- -You will need to bring your own chairs and we ask that you social distance and only sit with you household group in designated seating areas.
- -Baseball seating areas will be around the outfield fence.
- -Softball seating areas will be around the outfield fence.
- -Spectators from both home and visiting fans will be allowed.
