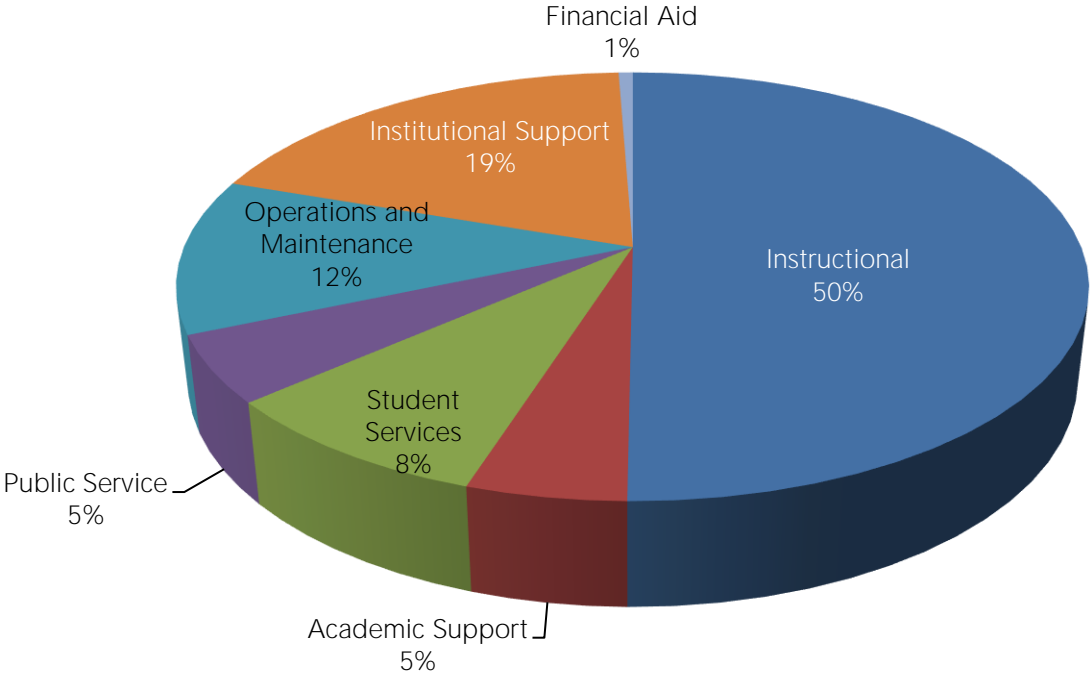
LAKE LAND COLLEGE'S TECHNOLOGY AVAILABILITY
2,500 virtual and 75 physical machine desk tops available on campus and at off-site locations
1,400 virtual and 50 physical machine desk tops in labs and classrooms for student use
100% of administrative, faculty, and staff offices as well as desired labs are networked
Student email is available
Wireless access to the Internet is accessible in all common areas of Lake Land College
Lake Land College has a 130Mb pipe via the ICN and 100Mb via Mediacom for backup and redundancy for internet access.
All classrooms have at minimum: instructor computer, multi-media configuration with speakers, CD, DVD, and VCR, projector, and document camera. Twenty four classrooms also have a symposium device. Interactive response units are also available for faculty to use in the classroom.
To support classroom instruction, courses that require specific software for coursework are available from anywhere via the virtual machine environment. In addition, nine classrooms now also have smart boards to support specific instruction and content.
