

# ANNUAL GRADUATION FAST FACTS

JULY 2016

## COLLEGE STUDENTS

- 975 students graduated from Lake Land College with a degree or certificate in Fiscal Year 2016.
- A total of 1,146 degrees and certificates were awarded to the 975 graduating students.
- Around 60% of graduates received degrees, 30% received certificates, and 98 received degrees and certificates.
- 65% of graduates were female and 35% were male.
- 58% of graduates were of traditional age (i.e., 17 to 23) and 42% were 24 or older.
- 40% of graduates were dual credit participants.
- 27% of awards were transfer degrees (AA, AES, or AS) and the remaining 73% were AAS (31%), ALS (3.4%) and certificates (38%).

  - AAS 31.2%
  - AES 0.3%
  - ALS 3.4%
  - AS 17.5%
  - CRT 38%
- Percent of total degrees and certificates by Division
  - Agriculture 9.2%
  - Allied Health 25.2%
  - Business 26.9%
  - Humanities 4.7%
  - Math and Science 7.8%
  - Social Science and Education 11.1%
  - Technology 11.7%

## DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS (DOC)

- 1,943 DOC students graduated from Lake Land College with a degree or certificate in Fiscal Year 2016.
- A total of 2,626 degrees and certificates were awarded to the graduating students.
- Around 8% received degrees, 87% received certificates, and 5% received degrees and certificates.
- 100% of DOC graduates were male. Lake Land does no longer provides services to female correctional facilities.
- 45% of graduates were African American, 41% were Caucasian, and 9% were Hispanic.
- 93% were 24 years and older.
- 10% of awards were Associate in Liberal Studies degrees and the remaining 90% were certificates.
- Southwestern Illinois Correctional Center produced the most DOC degrees and certificates (9.6%) in FY16.
- Most popular programs awarding certificates across all correctional sites
  - 18.6% Custodial Maintenance
  - 23.36% Construction Occupations I and II
  - 6.2% Food Service
  - 8.7% Culinary Arts I and II
  - 6.7% Restaurant Management I and II
