

# ANNUAL GRADUATION FAST FACTS

JULY 2017

## COLLEGE STUDENTS

- 1,060 students graduated from Lake Land College with a degree or certificate in Fiscal Year 2017.
- A total of 1,283 degrees and certificates were awarded to the 1,060 graduating students.
- Around 54% of graduates received degrees, 35% received certificates, and 12% received degrees and certificates.
- 64% of graduates were female and 36% were male.
- 58% of graduates were of traditional age (i.e., 17 to 23) and 42% were 24 or older.
- 41% of graduates were dual credit participants.
- 24% of awards were transfer degrees (AA, AES, or AS) and the remaining 76% were AAS (27%), ALS (2.9%) and certificates (45%).

- Percent of total degrees and certificates by Division
  - Agriculture 11.5%
  - Allied Health 28.5%
  - Business 22.7%
  - Humanities 4.4%
  - Math and Science 6.8%
  - Social Science and Education 9.9%
  - Technology 13.37%

## DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS (DOC)

- 1,849 DOC students graduated from Lake Land College with a degree or certificate in Fiscal Year 2017.
- A total of 2,665 degrees and certificates were awarded to the graduating students.
- Around 9% received degrees, 83% received certificates, and 8% received degrees and certificates.
- 100% of DOC graduates were male. Lake Land does no longer provides services to female correctional facilities.
- 41% of graduates were African American, 44% were Caucasian, and 9% were Hispanic.
- 94% were 24 years and older.
- 12% of awards were Associate in Liberal Studies degrees and the remaining 88% were certificates.
- Southwestern Illinois Correctional Center produced the most DOC degrees and certificates (11%) in FY17.
- Most popular programs awarding certificates across all correctional sites
  - 17.1% Custodial Maintenance
  - 19.5% Construction Occupations I and II
  - 18.1% Culinary Arts I and II
  - 3.8% Restaurant Management I and II
