

ANNUAL GRADUATION FAST FACTS

August 2019

COLLEGE STUDENTS

- 1,045 students graduated from Lake Land College with a degree or certificate in Fiscal Year 2019.
- A total of 1,293 degrees and certificates were awarded to the 1,045 graduating students.
- Around 58% of graduates received degrees, 28% received certificates, and 14% received degrees and certificates.
- 58% of graduates were female and 42% were male.
- 61% of graduates were of traditional age (i.e., 17 to 23) and 39% were 24 or older.
- 45% of graduates had been dual credit participants during high school.
- 27% of awards were transfer degrees (AA, AES, or AS) and the remaining 73% were AAS (30.7%), ALS (2.9%) and certificates (39.4%).

- Percent of total degrees and certificates by Division
 - Agriculture 11%
 - Allied Health 21.7%
 - Business 26.7%
 - Humanities 3.6%
 - Math and Science 6.9%
 - Social Science and Education 11.8%
 - Technology 15.5%

DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS (DOC)

- 1,860 DOC students graduated from Lake Land College with a degree or certificate in Fiscal Year 2019.
- A total of 2,638 degrees and certificates were awarded to the graduating students.
- Around 5% received degrees, 95% received certificates, and 0% received degrees and certificates.
- 99.4% of DOC graduates were male.
- 41% of graduates were African American, 45% were Caucasian, and 9% were Hispanic.
- 93.5% were 24 years and older.
- 7% of awards were Associate in Liberal Studies degrees and the remaining 93% were certificates.
- Most popular programs awarding certificates across all correctional sites
 - 16.9% Custodial Maintenance
 - 21.4% Construction Occupations I and II
 - 18.7% Culinary Arts I and II
 - 19.3% Horticulture
