

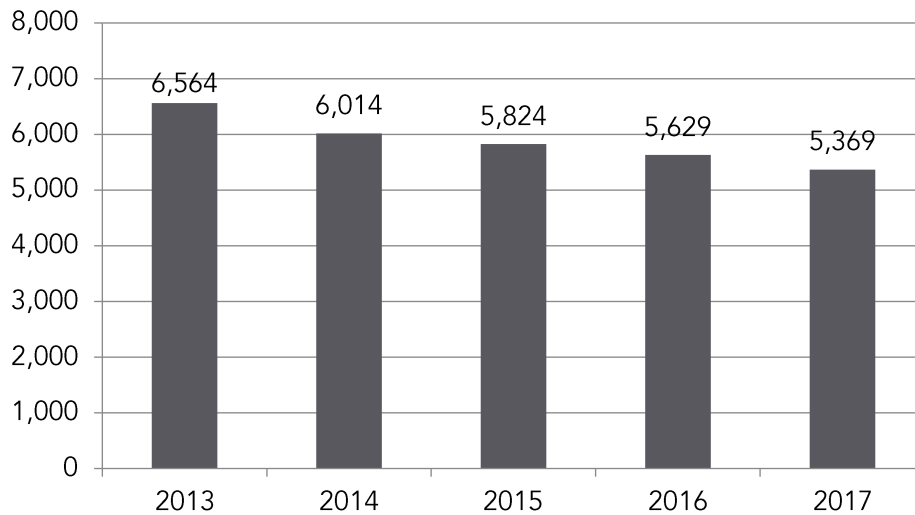
# ENROLLMENT SUMMARY

## SPRING 2017 TENTH DAY

The Tenth Day Enrollment Summary provides a snapshot of the college's opening enrollment for Spring 2017 and includes the State Report required for submission to the Illinois Community College Board. This report includes only enrollment in college classes; enrollment in Department of Corrections educational programs is not included.

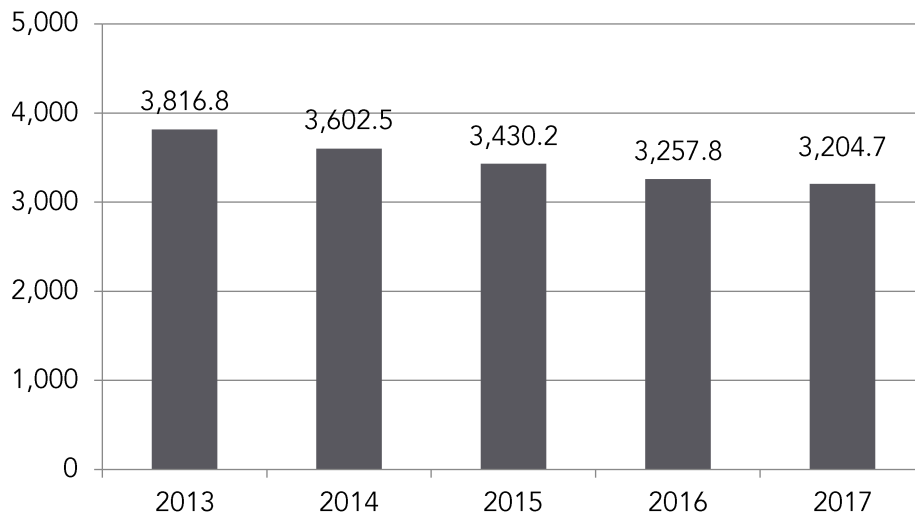
There are 5,369 students enrolled in Lake Land College classes this semester. This is a decrease of 4.6% (260 students) compared to Spring 2016 (5,629).

Number of Students Enrolled (Headcount)



The total overall full-time equivalent (FTE) enrollment is 3,204.7 (48,069 credit hours). This is a 1.6% decrease (53.2 FTE) compared to Spring 2016 (3,257.8 FTE). 1 FTE = 15 credit hours.

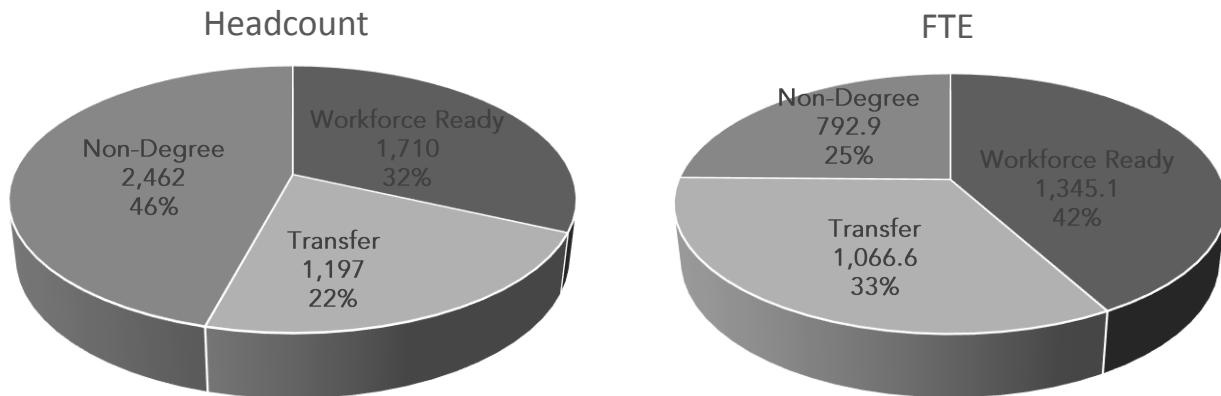
Credit Hours/Full-Time Equivalent



Of the 5,369 students enrolled:

- 32% (1,710) are pursuing a Workforce Ready Associate in Applied Science, Associate in Liberal Studies/Career Track or Certificate Program.
- 22% (1,197) are pursuing a transfer Associate in Arts, Science or Engineering Science Degree.
- 46% (2,462) are enrolled in classes but are not currently pursuing a college degree or certificate. This includes students enrolled in our high school dual credit program and students enrolling in specific courses for transfer or technical skill development.

### Enrollment by Academic Program



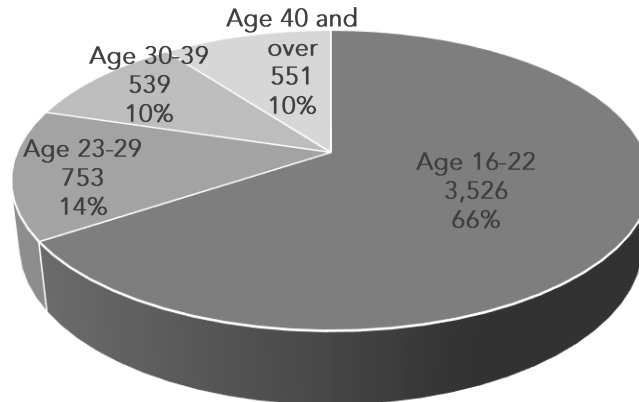

Of the 5,369 students enrolled:

- 66% (3,526) fit the definition of “traditional age” college student which is up through age 22. This is an increase of 58 students (1.7%) compared to Spring 2016 (3,468).
- 14% (753) are age 23 to 29, a decrease of 80 students (10%) compared to Spring 2016 (833).
- 10% (539) are age 30 to 39, a decrease of 68 students (13%) compared to Spring 2016 (607).
- 10% (551) are age 40 and over, a decrease of 170 students (24%) compared to Spring 2016 (721).

### Enrollment by Age

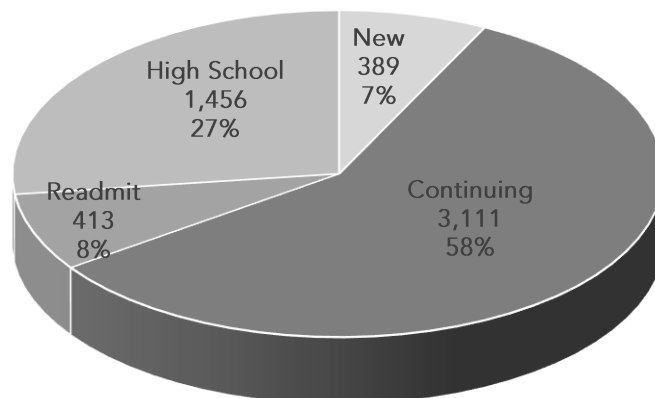


Average Age: 24      Median Age: 20      Modal Age: 18

Of the 5,369 students enrolled:

- 58% (3,111) are continuing students who were enrolled in Lake Land College classes during the past year. This is a decrease of 332 students (11%) compared to Spring 2016 (3,443).
- 8% (413) are readmitting students who previously attended Lake Land College but were not enrolled during the past year, a decrease of 14 students (3%) compared to Spring 2016 (427).
- 7% (389) are attending Lake Land College for the first time. 192 are new college students and 197 are students transferring from another college. This is a decrease of 47 students (9%) compared to Spring 2016 (436).
- 27% (1,456) are current high school students enrolled in dual credit, an increase of 133 students (10%) compared to Spring 2016 (1,323).

## OTHER SPRING 2017 ENROLLMENT HIGHLIGHTS

- 59% (3,170) of the students are enrolled part-time; 41% (2,199) are enrolled full-time. This is similar to previous Spring terms.
- 84 students are enrolled through the Dislocated Worker Program. This is a decrease of 38 students from Spring 2016 (122).
- 1,754 students (33%) are enrolled in at least one Internet class which is a decrease of 47 students compared to Spring 2016; 514 students (10%) are enrolled in only Internet classes, an increase of 17 students. Internet enrollment accounts for 9,850.5 credit hours of enrollment (657 FTE) which is an increase of 18 FTE compared to Spring 2016 and 21% of the Spring 2017 total college credit hour enrollment.
- 436 students are enrolled in at least one course at the Kluthe Center; 167 students are enrolled only at Kluthe. Kluthe enrollment increased 37 students (9%) compared to Spring 2016 (399).
- There are 48 international students enrolled representing 20 different countries. The country with the highest number of students represented is Congo (18). Other countries include Belgium, Brazil, Canada, China, Columbia, Haiti, Hong Kong, India, Iran, Korea, Netherlands, Nigeria, Pakistan, Romania, Russia, Saudi Arabia, Turkey, United Kingdom, and Vietnam. 5 of the students are new to the college this semester. Spring semester international enrollment the previous five years was 2016 = 54, 2015 = 41, 2014 = 38, 2013 = 38, and 2012 = 44.
