

Smoking and the Use of Tobacco Products

Lake Land College is concerned with providing a healthy and productive work environment for its employees and students. Smoking and the use of tobacco products shall be prohibited on any property owned or operated by the College and in College vehicles.

Failure to comply may result in a fine per state guidelines* as posted on the Lake Land College Police Department website.

State law* provides an exception to this policy allowing use of tobacco products in personal vehicles more than 15 feet from any building entrance.

Definitions:

Smoking shall mean lighting or burning any type of material or using electronic cigarettes.

Tobacco products shall mean cigarette, cigar, pipe or tobacco in any form, including smokeless tobacco, which is any loose, cut, shredded, ground, powdered, compressed or leaf tobacco that is intended to be placed in the mouth without being smoked.
