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## **Committee Reports.**

### ICCTA/Legislative.

Trustee Walk said that the Illinois General Assembly is holding its veto session in October, she attended the ICCTA conference in September and is planning to attend the ICCTA November meetings in Naperville, as well as, the Governance Training Institute program provided by ACCT.

#### **Resource & Development.**

Trustee Reynolds, Committee Chair, said the Committee had not met since the last regular Board meeting.

#### Finance.

Trustee Lilly, Committee Chair, said the Committee did not meet, but some items will be discussed later in the agenda.

#### **Buildings & Site.**

Trustee Cadwell, Committee Chair, said the Committee had not met since the last regular Board meeting.

#### Foundation.

Trustee Lilly highlighted the following information and said this report was provided by Ms. Christina Donsbach, Executive Director for College Advancement:

- Foundation scholarship awarding just wrapped up for the 2025-2026 school year, and we're thrilled to share that over \$865,250 was awarded to 675 students. With 1,101 scholarship applicants overall, 61% of applicants received a scholarship, and an additional \$140,250 was awarded compared to last year. The Foundation is hosting a pizza party to celebrate our 2025-2026 scholarship recipients on November 19th.
- We couldn't be more excited to celebrate our 2025 Alumni and Foundation awardees on October 23rd. Congratulations to all of our award recipients!
- The Foundation is happy to share that Grayson Gough has been hired as our Foundation Awards & Corporate Relations Coordinator. Grayson previously worked in the Financial Aid office as the Financial Aid Scholarship Specialist.

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## Student Report.

Student Trustee Bliler reported since the last meeting of the Board, the Student Government Association (SGA) has convened five times. He said these meetings focused on several key initiatives, including preparations for the freshman delegate elections, which were held on September 10 and 11, 2025. Mr. Bliler announced the following students have been elected to serve as freshman delegates to the SGA and their appointments will be presented for formal approval later in this meeting:

He said the SGA looks forward to the contributions of these delegates as the SGA pursues its overarching goal of increasing student involvement and representation throughout the academic year. He said the SGA remains committed to expanding both the pool of election candidates and the number of student voters in future elections. Mr. Bliler said he anticipates that the inclusion of newly elected freshman delegates will provide valuable perspectives and further energize this effort. In addition, he said the SGA met with Vice President Nwosu to foster connection and engage in dialogue regarding student education initiatives, and this discussion centered on raising awareness of available academic options and proved to be a meaningful exchange. He said the insights gained informed subsequent leadership training. which took place on October 7, 2025. During this session, delegates established strategic goals and set a clear direction for the year ahead. The primary objective for the SGA this year—alongside its foundational mission of student representation—is to cultivate increased student involvement and enthusiasm within the campus community. Mr. Bliler said in addition to the goals of organization involvement, this initiative seeks to foster a student body that is actively engaged and invested in the student experience at Lake Land College. He said by broadening the scope and depth of student input, the SGA aims to better inform future SGA decisions. He said achieving this goal will require targeted information campaigns and intentional personal outreach, but he is confident that these efforts will yield long-term benefits for both current and future students, as well as the broader college community. The SGA also hosted a Red Cross Blood Drive, successfully meeting the target of 23 units collected. He said the next blood drive is scheduled for November 12, 2025.

Mr. Bliler said the Student Activity Board (SAB) continues to host weekly student events each Wednesday. He was pleased to report that SAB is planning a special Veterans' Day ceremony on November 5, 2025, to honor the courage and sacrifice of veterans within the college community and beyond. SAB is also working to diversify its programming to better serve

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students across various learning modalities and majors. SAB has promoted the scheduling survey to gather student feedback and is preparing to launch the Laker Club Showcase at the beginning of the Spring semester. He said this event is designed to encourage greater student participation in clubs and organizations.

Mr. Bliler said The Navigator News is fully staffed for the semester and has successfully published the October issue. The team continues to highlight the most compelling stories from Lake Land College, serving both the campus and the broader community. He said students across campus participated in the Special Olympics Family Festival, hosted at Lake Land last month, and it was heartening to witness volunteers from the college and surrounding areas come together in support of such a benevolent and impactful event.

Mr. Bliler said that in continuing our recognition of student organizations, he highlighted the agriculture-based clubs on campus. These organizations provide industry-relevant education beyond the classroom through events, guest speakers, and industry tours. He said the Lake Land Agriculture clubs offer students from all majors the opportunity to engage with agricultural professionals and explore the industry that holds deep historical and economic significance for the Lake Land College community.

Mr. Bliler extended his sincere appreciation to the Board for their continued support on behalf of the Lake Land student body.

### President's Report.

Dr. Bullock gave the following updates:

- The College received \$757,148 in September from the Illinois Department of Corrections for the FY 2025 outstanding balance. The IDOC is paid in full for FY 2025.
- The College received \$44,014 in September from the Illinois Department of Juvenile Justice for the FY 2025 outstanding balance. The IDJJ is paid in full for FY 2025.
- The College received no payments from the Illinois Department of Corrections or Illinois Department of Juvenile Justice in September toward the FY 2026 balance of \$507,880 for DOC and \$13,561 for DJJ.
- In September, the College received \$345,542 from the State of Illinois for FY 2026 credit hour reimbursement and \$514,412 for equalization, and no funds toward CTE. A total of \$10.1 million remains outstanding.
- The College received property tax payments totaling \$3.2 million in September.

Ms. Jean Anne Highland, Chief of Staff, presented on the planning and progress of the new strategic priority. Ms. Highland said the presentation is available on the College's shared drive at S:\Strategic planning.

# Focus on Advancing Student Success - Agriculture Division for Student Outreach.

Mr. Ryan Orrick, Division Chair for Agriculture, commended the agriculture faculty for their successful recruitment and outreach efforts, highlighting the high success rates in the agriculture division.

#### Announcement of 2025-2026 Student Ambassadors.

Ms. Heather Nohren, Vice President for Student Services, announced the selection of the 2025-2026 Student Ambassadors. She said fifteen highly qualified candidates were selected to serve on the ambassador team as official representatives of Lake Land College and will each receive a \$1,000 yearly scholarship.

# **Curriculum Committee Highlights.**

Dr. Ike Nwosu, Vice President for Academic Services, presented the listing of new courses and curricula, as well as changes in current courses and curricula that were brought before the Curriculum Committee and approved from April 2025 to September 2025.

### Acceptance of Grant(s).

Ms. Highland highlighted for the Board that the College has received a five-year TRIO Student Support Services (SSS) Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) grant from the United States Department of Education. Trustees learned the first-year award will be \$272,346. Trustees reviewed a memo from Dr. Beth Craig, Grants Writer and Coordinator, that detailed how the College will utilize this grant to serve an additional 120 low-income, first-generation, and/or disabled students through this project.

Ms. Highland presented to the Board the \$12,500 Growing Agricultural Science Teachers (GAST) grant from the Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE). She said that this grant has been received by the Agriculture Division, and the purpose of the grant is to recruit, develop, and retain agricultural education teachers, as there is a shortage of such teachers within the state and nationwide.

Trustee Cadwell moved and Trustee Reynolds seconded to accept as presented a five-year grant with the first-year award of \$272,346 from the United States Department of Education for the TRIO Science Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) grant and to accept, as presented, a \$12,500 grant award from the Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) for the Growing Agricultural Science Teachers (GAST) grant.

# Approval of Resolution No. 1025-003 – Intent to Continue Foundation Tax Levy.

Mr. Woodruff recommended that the Board approve Resolution No. 1025-003 – Intent to Continue Foundation Tax Levy. Trustees reviewed details of the Resolution. Mr. Woodruff said under provisions of the Illinois Statute, 110 ILCS, 805/3-14.3, community colleges in the state of Illinois are authorized to levy a foundation tax on an annual basis in order to bring the overall tax levy of the education and operations and maintenance funds of the respective community colleges up to the most recently reported statewide average actual levy rate of all community colleges in the state. He said the Resolution requests permission of the Board of Trustees to continue the tax levy for the foundation tax for another year.

Trustee Reynolds moved and Trustee Cadwell seconded to approve, as presented, resolution 1025-003 – Resolution of Intent to Continue the Foundation Tax Levy. [A full and complete copy of the Resolution is attached to and part of these minutes.]

#### Certification of Fall Student Government Association Election Results.

Trustees reviewed a memorandum from Ms. Lisa Shumard-Shelton, Director of Student Life, detailing the results of the election. Ms. Nohren said that since the Board recognizes the SGA as the representative body for all students, Board approval is sought to certify the results.

Trustee Deters moved and Trustee Reynolds seconded to certify, as presented, the results of the Student Government Association Election held September 10-11, 2025.

# Approval of Medical and Dental Insurance Administrator Fees and Health, Dental and Vision Insurance Plan Rates.

Trustees reviewed a recommendation from Mr. Woodruff for the Board to approve the renewal of the College's health, dental, and vision insurance plans with Aetna for 2026. Mr. Woodruff reported that the administration and the College's Health Insurance Committee have been working with the College's insurance consultant, Gallagher, to renew the employee health, dental, and vision insurance. Mr. Woodruff reported that after extensive review, he and the College's Health Insurance Committee recommend that we proceed with the renewal with Aetna for plan year 2026.

Trustees learned that the contract with Aetna is for a three-year term and would include no increase in the medical administrative fee in year 1; years 2 and 3 would each include a 3% increase. The total medical administrative fee for the term of the three-year agreement will be \$525,052. The proposal represents a 0% change in the annual administration fee compared to the prior year, and overall would represent a 3% cost increase to the College for the medical insurance bundle and a dental renewal increase of 15.34%. The administration recommended passing along these costs to the employees. Trustees also reviewed details of the impact to employees for these proposed premium rates based on their various plan options (e.g., single, single+1, and family).

Trustee Montgomery moved and Trustee Cadwell seconded to approve, as presented, a 3-year renewal with Aetna of Hartford, Connecticut, for medical and dental insurance

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administrative fees at a total cost of \$525,052, broken down as follows: calendar year 2026, \$169,862; calendar year 2027, \$174,960; and calendar year 2028, \$180,230.

# Approval of Distribution of Funds from FY 2025 Fund Balance to the Restricted Health Insurance Fund Balance.

Mr. Woodruff presented the Board with information on current healthcare costs and the expectation that these costs will continue to increase. Mr. Woodruff requested that the Board approve the distribution \$1 million of the approximate \$2.3 million anticipated fund (unaudited) balance from fiscal year 2025.

Trustee Walk moved and Trustee Montgomery seconded to approve as presented the distribution of \$1 million of the anticipated fiscal year 2025 fund balance to the Restricted Health Fund contingent that the College, upon audit completion, has fiscal year 2025 excess funds balance exceeding \$2 million.

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### Approval of Bid for Kluthe Fire Alarm System.

Mr. Woodruff presented a recommendation for the Board to approve the bid from Commercial Electric, Inc. of Mattoon, Illinois, in the amount of \$39,945, for the Kluthe Fire Alarm System. Trustees reviewed the bid tabulation sheet, which detailed that Commercial Electric, Inc. submitted the lowest of the three bids received.

Trustee Lilly moved and Trustee Reynolds seconded to approve, as presented, the proposal received by Commercial Electric, Inc. of Mattoon, Illinois, for the total amount of \$39,945 for the Kluthe Center Fire Alarm System Replacement Project.

#### Approval of Bid for John Deere Engine.

Mr. Woodruff presented a recommendation for the Board to approve the bid from CK Power, of St. Louis, Missouri, in the total amount of \$71,090 for the purchase of a John Deere 9.0L Final Tier 4 Engine. Mr. Woodruff said the John Deere 9.0L Final Tier 4 Engine is designed for heavy-duty agricultural and industrial applications. He said it features advanced emissions control technologies and is compliant with Final Tier 4 (FT4) emissions standards. The addition of this engine would ensure students train on industry-relevant John Deere technology, making them job-ready. Mr. Woodruff said that the college will be reimbursed the total amount of \$71,090 by the Perkins Grant.

Trustee Cadwell moved, and Trustee Walk seconded to approve, as presented, the bid from CK Power, St. Louis, Missouri, in the total amount of \$71,090 for the John Deere 9.0L Final Tier 4 Engine. The college will be reimbursed the total amount of \$71,090 by the Perkins Grant.

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### Approval of Bid for Janitorial Services at the Effingham Technology Center.

Trustees heard a recommendation from Mr. Woodruff for the Board to approve the bid from ESS Clean Inc. of Urbana, Illinois, for general office cleaning services for all three floors (Option 1) of the Effingham Technology Center (ETC), as well as an alternate bid (Option 2) for cleaning the main and lower levels. The request was to provide a month-to-month agreement. Trustees reviewed the bid tabulation sheet detailing ESS Clean Inc. as submitting the lowest of two bids received.

Trustee Deters moved, and Trustee Walk seconded, to approve, as presented, the proposal to utilize ESS Clean Inc. of Urbana, Illinois, in the interim until the College hires its own custodial staff. The annual cost associated with the month-to-month agreement is not to exceed \$120,000.

# Approval of Purchase of Furniture for a Classroom at the Effingham Technology Center.

**RE:** Proposed Tax Levy

Each year the College is required to submit a tax levy (dollar amount) to the Coles County Circuit Clerk by the fourth Tuesday of December so we are eligible to collect property tax revenue. This year the levy is for the equalized assessed value (EAV) of property for the year 2025, known as the levy year. Property taxes are paid the following summer/fall, calendar year 2026, and applied to fiscal year 2027 revenues.

Attached is the Certificate of Tax Levy for the 2025 levy year, the receipt form will be returned to us from each county clerk indicating filing of the Certificate of Tax Levy in that county, and the Certificate of Compliance certifying compliance with the "Truth in Taxation" law.

We are in legal compliance with the above, and I recommend approval of the appropriate documents shown above.

Lake Land's rate of levy for the 2024 levy year property values was \$.5065 per \$100 EAV. We will not know the actual tax rate for the 2025 levy year until late spring when EAV's are finally determined by the 15 individual counties in the Lake Land College district but we are estimating that our rate of levy will increase to approximately \$.5100 per \$100 EAV, a .69% increase in the amount levied overall.

For the individual taxpayer, Lake Land's tax is approximately 5% of the total bill and reflects the low overall tax rate per \$100 EAV for the College.

I recommend the sum of Seventeen Million Three Hundred Five Thousand Dollars (\$17,305,000) plus an additional amount to provide funds to retire bonds and pay interest thereon to be levied on the equalized assessed value of the taxable property of Community College District No. 517 for the levy year 2025 to be collected in the calendar year 2026. The levy for the year 2025 is to be allocated 100% for fiscal year 2027.

RE: Proposed revisions to Board Policy 02.16 – Freedom of Information Act

Board Policy 02.16 acknowledges the Board of Trustees' and College's commitment to ensure compliance with the Freedom of Information Act and any requests per this law. However, as the Policy is currently written, it also includes details of the Act that have changed over time as well as the likelihood of additional changes with future law amendments. Following guidance from our legal counsel, Robbins Schwartz, we recommend removing from Policy various details related to Freedom of Information requests and instead reference our compliance and/or commitment of this law along with our four appointed Freedom of Information Act Officers or trained designees, who will in turn maintain any procedural documents and processes.

We respectfully present proposed revisions as first reading for the November 2025 regular Board meeting, and will bring this request back to the Board for approval during the December 2025 regular Board meeting.

<u>Recommended motion:</u> Following first reading in November, 2025, approve as presented proposed revisions in December 2025 to Board Policy 02.16 – *Freedom of Information Act.*

#### Freedom of Information Act

The Board of Trustees will ensure that all meetings are open to the public and that the provisions of the Illinois Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) are adhered to. The Board will make available for inspection or copying all public records, except as otherwise exempted by the Act, when a written request is submitted. Each request will be complied with or denied within five (5) business days after it is received. The denial shall be by letter from the President of the College or his/her designee. The time limit may be extended for five (5) additional business days for reasons prescribed by the law. Requests calling for all records falling within a category shall be complied with unless compliance with the request shall be unduly burdensome for the College and there is no way to narrow the request, and the burden on the College outweighs the public interest in the information. Before invoking this exemption, the College shall extend to the person making the request an opportunity to confer in order to attempt to reduce the request to manageable proportions.

The Board of Trustees has designated individuals in the following positions as FOIA Officers for the College: The Comptroller, the Dean of Admission Services Enrollment & Student Success, the Director of Human Resources, and the Director of Marketing and Public Relations. All requests should be directed to one of the above individuals, who shall be trained in compliance with State law. Contact information for the FOIA Officers shall be maintained on the College's Web site along with a copy of the College's FOIA policy. Requestors are encouraged to submit requests via the email address of FOIA-Request@lakelandcollege.edu as this will automatically generate the request to all four FOIA Officers for the College.

In order to reasonably reimburse the College for its actual cost for reproducing and certifying public records and for the use, by any person, of the equipment of the public body to copy records, the following fee schedule is established:

1. For the first 50 pages of black and white, letter- or legal-sized copies, there will be no charge.

- 2. Each black and white, letter- or legal-sized copy in excess of 50 will be 15 cents (\$.15) for each page copied.
- 3. The charge for different or irregular size copies shall be the actual cost for the reproduction thereof.
- 4. The cost of certifying each copy or page shall be \$1.00 per copy or page.
- 5. Electronic copies will be charged at the actual cost of purchasing the recording medium such as a CD or disc.

Lake Land College has received a one-year grant for \$109,978.80 from the Illinois Community College Board (ICCB) Noncredit Strategies at Work grant (NSAW). This grant program was created to support noncredit training and business solution initiatives at community colleges. This is the third year the College has received this grant.

For the third year of this grant, grant funds will be used to provide free STEM training to in district K-12 teachers at the Maker's Space Lab at the Effingham Technology Center. Teachers will receive continuing education units for their participation. RE: September 2025 (Fiscal Year 2026) Financial Statement Summary

Please find below a summary of September's actual results compared to the approved budget. We are now 25% or three months into the new Fiscal Year. At this time, there are no results, concerns, or indications that I'm aware of that would create cause for concern at this time. We continue to monitor the Governor's Executive Order relating to a budgetary set-aside of 4% for state agencies. At this time, there are no additional official communications.

September - Noteworthy Events Impacting Results

- Results from Daily Operations Nice recovery in September. YTD we are favorable by \$787K. Ongoing expense control is helping offset the unfavorable YTD budget revenue variance. Salaries and wages are now reflective of payout now accounting for the 3<sup>rd</sup> paycheck note from last month.
- Revenue Revenue for September was favorable by \$228K but we remain unfavorable YTD to budget by \$1.2M. This is comprised of equalization (\$754K), CTE (\$280K), and CPPRT (\$107K) payments not received in Q1.
- Expenditures Daily operational expenditures for the month of September are favorable to the budget by \$820K. YTD expenditures associated with daily operations are \$1.9M favorable.
- Funds There are only a couple of noteworthy items. As noted, there is an
  awareness/slight concern related to the potential year-end TORT balance. The college is
  taking steps within the parameters of our tax levy options to reduce the deficit balance.
  Also, Fund 5, although shows a loss of \$661K, we had anticipated loss of \$741K.
   September accounted for \$353K in athletic tuition waivers. The College farm had another
  \$125K in expenses, neither of which was offset by revenue accounted for in September.



RE: Proposed revisions to Board Policy 02.02 – Student Trustee

Board Policy 02.02 – *Student Trustee* establishes basic requirements for the election and ongoing eligibility for any student trustee on an annual basis. The relevant section in the Illinois Community College Act also includes basic eligibility, which is enrollment status at a community college. Please find attached proposed revisions to the College's Board Policy so that our language aligns with current language in the Illinois Community College Act, 110 ILCS 805/3-7.24.

Because this recommendation is to align our Policy with existing Illinois Community College Act language, I respectfully request the Board waive first reading.

### **Student Trustee**

The Lake Land College Board of Trustees shall have one student member who is enrolled in Lake Land College. The student member shall have all the privileges of membership, including the right to make and second motions, to attend closed sessions, to voice an advisory vote on action items, and to have this advisory vote recorded in the minutes of the meeting.<sup>1</sup>

## 1. Election of the Student Board Member

The Student Board Member election shall be conducted by the Lake Land College Student Government Association at a campus-wide student referendum annually in March. Candidates must, on the date of the election, be enrolled as full-time students and be citizens of the United States, residents of the State and the Lake Land College district, as specified in Board Policy and noted on their residency status in the Admissions and Records Office. Once elected, the student trustee member must maintain a semester and cumulative 2.00 grade point average or higher, continue to maintain full-time enrollment status for the fall and spring semester of their term, and should attend two Student Government Association meetings per month, preferably the meetings immediately before and after regularly scheduled Board of Trustees meetings. enrolled in the College during the time the election is held shall be eligible to vote in the secret ballot election. If the elected member vacates the position for any reason, the successor will be selected by the elective process within thirty (30) days of Board of Trustees action on the vacancy.

## 2. Term of Office

The College Board of Trustees shall approve the election of the student member during the April Board meeting each year. The student member shall then serve a term of one year beginning on April 15.

**Subject:** Worker's Compensation Policy

We have recently reviewed our renewal for our Worker's Compensation Insurance coverage for our policy with Illinois Public Risk Fund (IPRF) for calendar year 2026. The renewal rate of \$170,608 reflects an increase of \$5,690 (3.45%) over our previous coverage. The \$170,608 includes an administrative fee of \$4,969. Despite the slight increase, we support staying with IPRF.

The mod rating for the College increased from .86 to .89. Last year the MOD rate increased from .74 to .86. This rating involves reviewing the prior 3 years of claims. An experience mod of less than 1.00 is better than average to organizations/businesses of similar size and industry. We currently have 2 open claims with a reserves balance of \$32,151.63.

The College also qualifies for the Safety Grant from IPRF. In calendar year 2026 we will receive \$14,389 which is a decrease of \$4,388 from the prior year. These funds will be used to enhance safety throughout campus.

**Recommended motion**: Approve as presented the renewal of the Worker's Compensation policy with IPRF for calendar year 2026 in the amount of \$170,608 through Dimond Brothers Insurance of Mattoon, IL.

**RE:** Approval of EAB Virtual Tour (YouVisit) Agreement – Retroactive Board Approval

Approval is requested to retroactively approve the College's subscription to EAB Virtual Tour, branded as YouVisit, to provide an interactive, web-based campus tour experience for prospective students and families. This virtual tour is embedded on various pages throughout the College's website, allowing visitors to explore campus facilities and student life through immersive 360° media and videos.

The Virtual Tour platform is provided by EAB Global, Inc., the same vendor that offers our EAB Navigate student success and advising solution. However, it is important to note that the Virtual Tour (YouVisit) product is completely separate from our EAB Navigate agreement. The Virtual Tour is a standalone module and has never been included as part of the Navigate package or its licensing terms.

Upon further review, it has been determined that the Virtual Tour renewal is covered under a three-year Program Order Form executed with EAB on May 30, 2023. The agreement includes the following annual terms and fees:

July 31, 2024 – July 30, 2025	\$24,311.00
July 31, 2025 – July 30, 2026	\$25,527.00

Although each year individually falls below the \$25,000 threshold, the three-year total commitment of \$72,991 exceeds the amount that requires Board of Trustees approval. It appears this agreement was never previously presented to the Board, likely because earlier renewals were below the reporting threshold. The College received the most recent invoice for the 2025–2026 program year in the amount of \$25,527.00, covering the period from July 31, 2025 – July 30, 2026.

Given the importance of maintaining a modern and accessible online campus experience for prospective students—and considering that the Virtual Tour has become a key part of our digital recruitment and marketing strategy—it is prudent to continue this solution as it remains a cost-effective and valuable tool that enhances student engagement and supports the College's recruitment efforts.

This is exempt from bidding per Board Policy 10.22 (#4.F.).

The College recently solicited bids for the Entrance Improvement Project at the Main Campus. The project scope entails comprehensive roadway and landscape enhancements at Entrances 1 & 2, and the addition of a new Entrance with a turn lane along Route 45. These improvements will enhance the entrance aesthetics, improve roadway conditions, and modernize infrastructure along Route 45 and is part of the Master Facility Plan.

For the bidding process, we advertised in major daily in-district newspapers and on the College's Facilities website and mailed the specifications to area contractors. A total of two bids were received. These include bid alternates for (1) Irrigation system installation, (2) Paver Art in lieu of standard pavers, (3) Concrete Roadway in lieu of asphalt paving (Podesta Dr), and (4) Dimensional Sign Letters in lieu of vinyl. Based on the bids received, I recommend that we award this bid to Kieffer Brothers Construction of Mt Carmel, Illinois, for the Entrance Improvement Project. Based on our master facility plan schedule, I recommend utilization of fund balance for this expense.

**RE:** Approval of Purchase of New Printers for Campus and DOC Locations

To keep printers and copiers current and supported, as well as realize potential cost savings, it is the practice of the College to monitor and maintain a copier's life for five to six years. On a monthly basis, the print shop audits click counts by units. Along with allocating to the appropriate budget, the data is used to right-size the unit and features with the assigned location. It is not unusual for units to be relocated to drive unit utilization. This monitoring includes all main campus locations and all remote locations, including DOC.

Dave Earp, Supervisor of Print and Mail Services, has been in negotiations with Konica Minolta and Ricoh to replace seventeen unsupported copiers/printers used in campus operations and DOC off-campus operations. These units are 6+ years old. As a result of the negotiations, the Print Shop is recommending the purchase of 17 Konica/Minolta Bizhub Printers/Copiers at a total cost of \$49,166.85, which will replace aged, unsupported units across seventeen Lake Land College locations. These units come with a 5-year warranty. The units include a per-copy cost of \$0.0044, which covers all labor and materials necessary to maintain/repair the units, as well as all necessary supplies, such as toner and staples. It does not include the cost of paper. Over a 5-year period, these 17 units generated approximately 3.2 million clicks. Assuming similar usage for the next 5 years, we'll save about \$12,700 in maintenance costs with the purchase of these units. We anticipate that maintenance costs will be approximately \$14,000 under the new agreement, assuming the same usage level.

Per Board Policy 10.4(f), a bid is not required for duplicating machines and supplies.

**Recommended Motion**: Approve as presented a purchase/service agreement with Konica Minolta Business Solutions of Peoria, IL, for \$49,166.85 for the purchase of 17 Konica/Minolta Bizhub units and a 60-month service agreement of \$.0044/page. The office copiers/printers will be located throughout Lake Land College's main campus, remote facilities, including DOC locations.



<u>Rationale:</u> The Wellness Center recommends the purchase of *Nook Huddle Pods* from School Outfitters, which is part of the state consortium, allowing Lake Land College to take advantage of competitively bid pricing and compliance with state procurement requirements.

These Nook Huddle Pods provide private, acoustically sound spaces that support small-group collaboration, counseling, and confidential discussions. 

Re: Temporary Lease with Deb's Catering – Effingham Technology Center Kitchen

On Sunday, October 19, a substantial fire tragically shut down Deb's Catering and The Giving Plate in Altamont. In addition to catering, the company provides essential meals to non-profit organizations such as Meals on Wheels and Head Start through a contract with CEFS.

In response to the situation, several community partners approached Lake Land about leasing the commercial kitchen space at the Effingham Technology Center to support Deb's Catering, which provides important community services during this challenging time.

After careful consideration and review, we recommend creating a temporary, month-to-month lease with Deb's Catering, which would enable them to resume providing prepared meals to the recipients of Meals on Wheels and Head Start programs.

The lease payment will include utilities, internal/external maintenance, and facility repairs. The rate we will be charging for use of the Kitchen and storage space (1,449 square feet) and required common areas is comparable to the Patterson lease agreement and area market rates. The lease will not include the cost of waste disposal and grease disposal service.

Recommended Motion: Approve as presented the temporary lease agreement between Lake Land College and Debs Catering of Altamont, IL, which will begin November 11<sup>th</sup> and run month to month. The monthly lease payment will be \$1,307. The intent is for this lease not to exceed 9 months.
