- (1) Must have a "C" or better in ENG 120, 121, COM 111, PHI 290, CIS 160, BUS 151, 152, 200, and 281
- (2) At least one science course must be a 4 credit hour lab course. Select from Approved General Education Courses
- (3) Select from Approved General Education Courses. One course should have a cultural diversity component.
- (4) Prerequisite: High school accounting, Accounting Processing (BUS085), Fundamentals of Accounting (BUS095), or consent of instructor.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- "D" grades will be accepted as long as overall GPA is a "C" average (2.0 or above on 4.0 scale). However, a "C" or better is required in the Core Business Courses and Composition I, Composition II and Public Speaking.
- Majors in the College of Business on-campus at EIU include: Accountancy, Finance, Management, Business Analytics & Information Systems, and Marketing. Online: Business Administration.

- Minors include: Accountancy, Business Analytics, Business Administration, Finance, Entrepreneurship, Human Resources, Management, Management Information Systems, Marketing, and Operations and Supply Chain Management.
- Business Administration majors transferring to EIU must have completed in high school, two years in the same foreign language with a grade of C or better. Students who have not satisfied this requirement will be required to complete six semester hours of college credit in the same foreign language with a grade of C or better. These hours may be completed at LLC or at the transfer institution.
- Students who plan to transfer to EIU without an A.A. degree will need to select general education courses approved for LLC. See your advisor.
