- 1. Applicant, parent, or guardian must be an "A" or "MM" Cumberland County Farm Bureau® member in good standing for one year prior to the scholarship application deadline.
- 2. Applicant must be a senior in high school graduating this spring who will be attending a college/university during the 2018 -2019 school year, or a college/university student currently enrolled or enrolling in the 2018 fall semester.
- 3. Applicant must be majoring in agriculture or an agriculture-related field. Additional points will be awarded for students majoring directly in agriculture.
- 4. Two (2) current letters of recommendation are required (as outlined in Section VI).
- 5. Current high school transcripts and/or college/university (if applicable) must accompany the application.
- 6. Please submit a wallet size head shot photo with application.
- 7. Applications must be typed or printed neatly.
- 8. Application deadline is March 29, 2018. The application, transcript, and letters of recommendation must be in our office on this date by 4:00 p.m. Return to:
