

- a. Provide proof of high school/secondary school completion (transcripts).
- b. Submit financial affidavit and corresponding bank statements.
- c. Provide a copy of your passport showing your legal name.

4. SEND YOUR LANGUAGE SCORES, IF APPLICABLE.

- a. TOEFL 61 ibt
- b. IELTS (academic module): 6.0
- c. iTEP (Academic): 3.6
- d. No score: we will test and place you for the Intensive English Language Program when you arrive.

5. RECEIVE I-20 AND ACCEPTANCE LETTER.

- a. Upon receipt, contact consulate for visa interview.
- b. Prepare for interview carefully.
- c. Attend interview.
- d. Provide copy of visa to Lake Land College.

6. MAKE HOUSING ARRANGEMENTS.

a. Contact International Studies Program for assistance.

7. MAKE TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS.

- a. Communicate with International Studies Program.
- b. Arrange flights.
- c. Arrange for airport pick up.

8. ATTEND ORIENTATION.
