CDC DEFINITION OF FULLY VACCINATED

- 2 weeks after second dose in a 2-dose series, such as Pfizer or Moderna vaccines; or
- 2 weeks after a single -dose vaccine, such as Johnson & Johnson's vaccine

You may visit campus after successfully completing the COVID-19 Campus Visit Screening Form.

You may visit campus if you are fever-free for 24 hours and can successfully complete the COVID-19 Campus Visit Screening Form.

You may visit campus once 10 days have passed since the onset of symptoms and you are fever free for 24 hours OR you have received a negative COVID-19 test since the onset of symptoms and can successfully complete the COVID-19 Campus Visit Screening Form.

You may visit campus after successfully completing the COVID-19 Campus Visitor Screening Form.

Following the date of your last "close contact" with the household member, you may return to campus:

- If the household member has received a negative COVID test result OR
- After 7 days if you receive a negative COVID test taken after day 5 and have had no symptoms OR
- After 10 days with no testing if you have had no symptoms OR
- After 14 days if you have not taken a COVID test or been monitoring your symptoms on a daily basis

CDC Definition of CLOSE CONTACT:

Independent of whether a mask was worn at the time:

- You were within 6 feet of someone who has COVID-19 for a total of 15 minutes or more
- You provided care at home to someone who is sick with COVID-19
- You had direct physical contact with the person (hugged or kissed them)
- You shared eating or drinking utensils
- They sneezed, coughed, or somehow got respiratory droplets on you
