2021-2022 Instructional Priorities

During the 2021-2022 academic year, the College launched a new Guided Pathways Enrollment Management Team. The Guided Pathways Enrollment Management Team is sponsored by the Vice President for Student Services and the Vice President for Academic Services. The team is chaired by the Associate Dean of Enrollment Management beginning in the Spring 2022. The team is designed to provide leadership and direction for the development and implementation of a Five-Year Guided Pathways Enrollment Management Project Plan: fiscal years 2023 – 2027.

The goal of the Guided Pathways Enrollment Management Team and Project Plan is two-fold:

- 1. Continue to scale implementation of the Guided Pathways model and continue to enhance and build upon strategies and supports to help students clarify their end goals, choose the most effective path to achieving those goals and stay on path to completion. The implementation of the Guided Pathways model is an integral part of the college's strategic enrollment management plan, as the Guided Pathways model itself is designed to improve enrollment through its emphasis on access and student success.
- 2. Implement a significant innovation, based on in-depth research and analysis, to grow enrollment.

IMPLEMENTING THE STUDENT TRACKING SYSTEM: EAB Navigate

The GPLT was previously tasked to identify elements needed in a student tracking system to monitor student success along the pathway and develop a plan for the College to identify students at-risk of falling off-track and supports to intervene in ways to help students get back on track. After extensive research and evaluation of the various software packages, the GPLT recommended that the College consider moving forward with EAB's Navigate. This product most fully aligns with the Guided Pathways model and meets the College's outlined needs.

What is Navigate?

Navigate is a retention and support product. It has the potential to alert students to potential roadblocks early and then link them to a person/office/service that can help. It also has the potential to alert instructors and advisors to student risk factors (low GPA, number of withdrawals/D grades/F grades, etc.) that may influence or inform strategies that faculty utilize to support students through advising or in their courses.

Navigate does not replace a particular system. It supplements what we already use to provide overall support for student success and retention. Datatel provides student information to Navigate, and we can load additional information that supports success and retention into Navigate (referrals to other campus offices, general advising notes, etc.) that is not shared back to Datatel.

There are three main areas to develop within Navigate: Early Alert (LEAP), Appointment Scheduling, and Academic Planning. Additionally, Lake Land is choosing to use Navigate for registration. Driving students to Navigate for registration will introduce them to support and services on campus that they may not be aware of, like tutoring and the food pantry.

There are several teams working on developing the Navigate functionality. The project leaders and teams will meet periodically with EAB staff to receive guidance and training for the implementation. Teams will pull in additional faculty and staff for consultation and decision-making as needed.

With Navigate, we are able to determine the level of functionality that teams will develop and utilize and the time-line for utilization. Counseling Services plan to start using Navigate to schedule advising appointments for spring 2023 advisement. Faculty advisors will tentatively begin using for summer/fall 2023 advisement.
