- Must be a graduating high school senior, current college/university/vocational student, and/or an adult returning to school.
- Must be a resident of the state of Illinois.

Submission:

Applications must be mailed in one sealed envelope, postmarked by **APRIL 1, 2024**.
Materials that are late or incomplete will not be accepted.

Disqualification:

- Failure to meet eligibility requirements
- Late or incomplete application
- Letters of recommendation from family or friends

Award Notification:

Applications will be reviewed by a scholarship committee. The minimum award is \$1,500. Scholarship winners will be notified by June 15th via email and postal mail. Winners will be posted on the GFWC Illinois Website.

If selected to receive a scholarship, the student will be required to show a letter of acceptance from the school the student will attend in the Fall, 2024 semester. Checks will be mailed and written directly to the college, university, or vocational school.

Application Items: the following MUST be included in the application packet

1. Resume with dates of participation. Include the following:
 - a. Extracurricular activities
 - b. Volunteer activities
 - c. Leadership positions
 - d. Detailed drama/theater background: performances, auditions, private lessons, courses, etc.
2. What are your ambitions and goals for the next 5 years? (250 word maximum)
3. GFWC is a service organization. What does service and volunteering mean to you?
How do you demonstrate your commitment to service? (250 word maximum)
4. Transcripts: high school (include ACT/SAT scores if taken), college/university/vocational transcripts
5. Two letters of recommendation from a teacher, coach, advisor, boss, or other professional source
 - a. Recommendations from family or friends will disqualify the applicant
6. Acting: digital copies (flash drive) of 3 performances, not to exceed a total of 15 minutes. Solo performances are preferred. Include the show and character names.
7. If not acting: include 3 descriptions and images of theater involvement, set creations, playwriting, etc. Include the show and character names as applicable.

NOTE: Materials submitted with the application will NOT be returned.
