- Letters of recommendation from family or friends

#### **Award Notification:**

Applications will be reviewed by a scholarship committee. The minimum award is \$1,500. Scholarship winners will be notified by June 15<sup>th</sup> via email and postal mail. Winners will be posted on the GFWC Illinois Website.

If selected to receive a scholarship, the student will be required to show a letter of acceptance from the school the student will attend in the Fall, 2024 semester. Checks will be mailed and written directly to the college, university, or vocational school.

- 5. Two letters of recommendation from a teacher, coach, advisor, boss, or other professional source
  - a. Recommendations from family or friends will disqualify the applicant
