\*Official Transcripts. By completeing the Greenville application, the student grants permission for Greenville to request transcripts of Lake Land College. The student must grant Lake Land College permission to provide transcripts to Greenville by completeing the Lake Land CollegeTranscript Request Form available online or from the Admissions and Records Office. Once permission has been grated by the student, continual sharing of transcripts will be managed by the appropriate office at each institution.
