Transfer Partnership

Millikin University and Lake Land College have developed a new transfer partnership.

Millikin University and Lake Land College have entered into a partnership that will facilitate a smooth transition from Lake Land to Millikin. Lake Land students who wish to transfer to Millikin will be provided with a plan of study, as well as automatic acceptance into a Millikin baccalaureate degree program upon successful completion of an Associate in Arts (AA), Associate in Science (AS), Associate in Engineering Science (AES) or Associate in Applied Science (AAS) with a 2.0 cumulative GPA.

Millikin-Lake Land Partnership Highlights

- » Transfer students with completed associate's degrees can complete their Millikin bachelor's degree in two years, assuming full-time enrollment.
- » Students transferring with a completed **AA or AS** degree will have completed 100% of Millikin's University Studies requirements.
- » Any graduate that has successfully completed the Lake Land Honors Program will be automatically accepted into the James Millikin Honors Program upon application.
- » The partnership is effective beginning with the 2024-2025 academic year.
