On behalf of our faculty and staff, I would like to express our appreciation to the area community college faculty for working with us to develop articulation agreements to our academic degree options. At the same time, we would like to invite all the community college students to "come join us" as you continue your educational pursuits.

By definition, articulation is the "process by which one institution matches its courses or requirements to course work completed at another institution". Students may use this course articulation to assure that the courses they complete at the community college will not have to be repeated at Murray State. Additionally, the articulation agreements that have been developed contain a degree plan that includes the courses taken at the community college and the additional MSU classes and requirements that will have to be taken to complete a Bachelor of Science in Agriculture. It is our hope that these agreements will assist students in determining what courses will be required for graduation.

Hutson School of Agriculture at MSU recognizes the importance and the quality of the programs at the regional community and technical colleges. Many of our best students in the past years have come to us through transfer programs. It is our desire to create a seamless and "transfer friendly" agreement that will encourage students to continue their educational pursuits at our university and to become engaged in the respective agricultural career of their choice.

Murray State University Articulation Agreement Provisions

1. Murray State University and Lake Land College agree to renegotiate this Agreement as may be deemed necessary to accommodate changes in program requirements, course content, employment trends, accreditation guidelines, institutional/graduation requirements, and/or other relevant factors.

2. Murray State University and Lake Land College each agree that it will observe all applicable regional accreditation standards, rules and guidelines. Each will advise the other as to any change in its accreditation status within twenty (20) days of receiving notice of such loss or change in accreditation.

3. Murray State University and Lake Land College agree to monitor and support the revisions of this Agreement to ensure consistency, program quality and transferability for the mutual benefit of all involved parties at both institutions. This Agreement will be reviewed by both institutions annually.

4. This Agreement will be considered in effect when signed by both parties. The Agreement is effective (subject to termination as set forth herein), unless review by Murray State University or Lake Land College determines curriculum revisions necessitate a new Agreement be created.

5. In the event that one of the parties declares a financial exigency and determines to close its program, written notice of same and termination of this Agreement shall be given to the other party as soon as practical. Otherwise, the Agreement may be terminated at any time without cause by either party upon written notice to the other party at least one year prior to the termination date. In any event, provisions will be made by Murray State University to allow students who have already enrolled at Murray State University to complete the program in a timely manner and/or in accordance with its teach-out plan.

6. Students of Lake Land College will be required to meet all admission standards of Murray State University.
