Student Ambassadors are a prestigious group of Lake Land College students, hand-selected to serve as official college representatives for recruitment purposes. In addition, Ambassadors conduct campus tours and assist with special functions sponsored by the College. Being a Student Ambassador is a challenging and rewarding experience. Here, you will meet new friends, gain leadership skills, and build your résumé all at the same time!

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Student Ambassadors must be enrolled on campus at least half-time for both the fall and spring semesters during the year of application.
- 2. Student Ambassadors must have a Lake Land College cumulative GPA of at least 2.50 as calculated by the College.
- 3. Student Ambassadors must remain in good academic and disciplinary standing.

SPECIAL PRIVILEGES AND ACTIVITIES

- 1. Each Student Ambassador will receive official Lake Land College Student Ambassador apparel valued at over \$125.
- 2. Student Ambassadors get to take part in specific trainings and social activities exclusively for them.
- 3. Student Ambassadors who complete the requirements will receive a \$1000 scholarship from Lake Land College for their year of service. The scholarship will be made in two payments: \$500 for the fall semester and \$500 for the spring semester. In order to receive the scholarship, each Ambassador must complete 10 credits of activity.
- 4. An award will be presented at the end of the year to the Student Ambassador who has shown outstanding efforts in promotion, recruitment, and service.

REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Participate in extensive training sessions.
- 2. Participate in mandatory functions that help in the recruitment, tour, and visit process.
- 3. Attend weekly meetings on Wednesdays or as otherwise announced. <u>Student Ambassador</u> <u>meetings should take precedence over other club meetings</u>.
- 4. Serve as an official representative of Lake Land College at career fairs, and other events that involve student recruitment.
- 5. Conduct campus tours and create a friendly, positive experience for prospective students.
- 6. Participate in letter-writing campaigns as needed.
- 7. Remain at least a half-time (6.0 credit hours) student during the fall and spring semesters and maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 2.50.
- 8. Complete at least 10 credits of activities each semester.

HOW TO APPLY

- 1. Complete and return the application and schedule an interview by Friday, August 29th.
- 2. Applications can be returned at the Admissions and Records office in the Luther Student Center or scanned and emailed to phartke@lakelandcollege.edu.
- 3. Interviews will be held on September 2nd, 3rd, and 4th. Returning ambassadors will interview September 2nd while any new applicants will interview the 3rd and 4th.
- 4. A list of times will be available at the Admissions and Records office where you can turn in your application. Schedule your interview by signing up when you drop off your application or by emailing <u>phartke@lakelandcollege.edu</u>.
- 5. Interviews are individual and will last about 20 minutes each in the Counseling Conference Room (LSC 440)
