



Greenville University - Lake Land College Associate of Arts Degree--Any Transfer Program Guide - Organizational Leadership

Completion of an Associate in Arts or Science degree at Lake Land College fulfills Greenville University's lower division general education requirements. Upon acceptance, students will need to fulfill program and university requirements at Greenville.

This "Transfer Program Guide" is an <u>example</u> of a proposed curriculum for students to use while completing their associate degree. Reading, writing and math placement could alter the course sequencing and transfer date. Therefore, students should begin sequencing their reading/writing (if applicable), math and science courses during the first semester, paying close attention to prerequisites. Students have the option of taking summer classes to lessen fall and spring course loads.

It is highly recommended that students meet with a LLC advisor each semester.
